ST. TIMOTHY: Born of a Jewish mother and a pagan father, St. Timothy was converted to Christianity by St. Paul, who after a few years discerned him to be a gifted evangelist. At first St. Timothy assisted St. Paul; later he became the first Bishop of Ephesus, where he received the two Epistles from St. Paul that bear his name. St. Timothy was known for his love of Sacred Scripture as a child, hence the depiction in stained glass on the front of this handout. He was martyred in 80 A.D.

I charge thee before God, Who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, Who gave testimony under Pontius Pilate, a good confession; that thou keep the commandment without spot, blameless, unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ; which, in His times, he shall show Who is the Blessed and only Mighty, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; Who alone hath immortality, and inhabiteth light inaccessible; Whom no man hath seen, nor can see; to Whom be honor and empire everlasting.
