In the 14 years since the church was originally threatened with demolition, millions of dollars have been raised towards a stunning restoration. Paintings, stained glass, architectural features, and statuary of the highest quality combine with dramatic modern lighting, spotless cleanliness, and attentive building maintenance to produce a breathtaking visual immersion into the Catholic Faith.
