# Invoking St. Michael the Archangel in the Tridentine Mass

A reader made an interesting observation that is worth relating: The Extraordinary Form of Holy Mass invokes St. Michael the Archangel at three points: 1) The priest's *Confiteor*, 2) The servers' *Confiteor*, and 3a) The first prayer of blessing of incense at the Offertory in a High Mass or 3b) The Prayer to St. Michael in the Prayers After Low Mass. In contrast, the Ordinary Form makes no reference to St. Michael.

St. Michael is our chief ally in defense against Satan. It behooves us to call upon his intercession frequently. Among the many graces that the Extraordinary Form offers is its inclusion of these prayers to St. Michael the Archangel. They are a few of the many aspects of the Tridentine Mass which seek to purify the faithful, both for the Most Holy Sacrifice being offered and for their lives in general.

### London, Ontario Tridentine Mass Resumes

There have been some changes in the London-area Tridentine Mass scene: The Sunday morning Mass at Windermere on the Mount Chapel had been discontinued several months ago. The Sunday noon Mass at St. Patrick, Kinkora has been discontinued in light of the reassignment of Fr. Paul Nicholson. In response, the Diocese of London has arranged for a new weekly Sunday Mass to debut, starting this Sunday, July 7 at 2:00 PM. For July and August it will be held at the chapel of John Paul II Catholic Secondary School, at 1300 Oxford Street in London. In September, the Mass will move to the chapel at Regina Mundi College [pictured], a former Junior Seminary.



Fr. Nicholson will coordinate the Mass; besides himself, the celebrants will include Frs. John Johnson, Tom Ferrera, Ross Bartley, Ray Lawhead, and Theo Pinto. Frs. Ferrera and Lawhead are new to the Extraordinary Form; we congratulate them and thank God for their willingness to celebrate the classic liturgy. Music will be directed by Toronto-based cantor David Domet, a fixture on the Toronto Tridentine Mass circuit.
