The Extraordinary Form at World Youth Day



The international young adults group Juventútem had its origins at World Youth Day in 2005. Not surprisingly, it plans a spectrum of events at the 2013 World Youth Day in Rio di Janeiro, Brazil this week, July 23-26. Most activities will be conducted at the historic Church of Our Lady of Carmel (pictured) in conjunction with the Apostolic Administration of St. John Vianney of Campos, Brazil, the world's only quasi-diocese which serves only those Catholics attached to the Traditional Latin Mass. Its Ordinary, Bishop Fernando Rifan, will be the celebrant of a Pontifical Mass, plus there will be one or two sung Masses every day.
