## *The Regina Caeli*

Now that the Easter season is upon us, it is time to pray the *Regina Caeli* in place of the *Angelus*. During Paschaltide (Holy Saturday through the Saturday after Pentecost), one can gain a Partial Indulgence for praying the *Regina Caeli* at dawn, at noon, or in the evening.

Regina caeli, laetare, allelujia:  
Quia quem meruisti portare, allelujia,  
Resurrexit, sicut dixit, allelujia.  
Ora pro nobis Deum, allelujia.

✠. Gaude et laetare, virgo Maria, allelujia.

✠. Quia surrexit Dominus vere, allelujia.

Orémus. Deus, qui per resurrectionem Filii tui Domini nostri Jesu Christi mundum laetificare dignatus es, praesta, quaesumus, ut per ejus Genetricem Virginem Mariam perpetuae capiamus gaudia vitae. Per Christum Dominum nostrum. Amen.

*Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia:  
For the Son thou wast privileged to bear, alleluia,  
Is risen as He said, alleluia.  
Pray for us to God, alleluia.*

✠. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, Alleluia!
