In 2003, the only option for attending a diocesan-approved Tridentine Mass in our region was the Sunday Mass held at a side altar Windsor's former Villa Maria Nursing [pictured]. Home When the **SARS** epidemic resulted in

the nursing home requiring the faithful to be sprayed down with disinfectant and sign a waiver form before entering the building, attendance plummeted to a diehard 10 people. That was the low point. Just 13 years later, we now enjoy 21 sites in metro Detroit and Windsor – four debuting this fall alone – which offer Holy Masses in the Extraordinary Form on a regular or semi-regular basis.
