## Cardinal Burke Mass Report

Another month, another major Tridentine Mass event: On Saturday, December 10, Raymond Cardinal Burke celebrated the first Pontifical Solemn Mass in the Extraordinary Form at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, Wisconsin. Built in 2005 at the initiative of then-Bishop Burke of the Diocese of La Crosse, the Shrine is arguably the most ornate church built in North America over the past two decades. Despite a modest amount of advance publicity, the church was filled with faithful.



In his homily, Cardinal Burke referred to the Pontifical Tridentine Mass as “Heaven descends upon earth”. Referring to the fact that the Shrine already hosts a weekly Sunday Tridentine Mass, His Eminence stated his intent there to return to celebrate additional Pontifical Masses in the future.

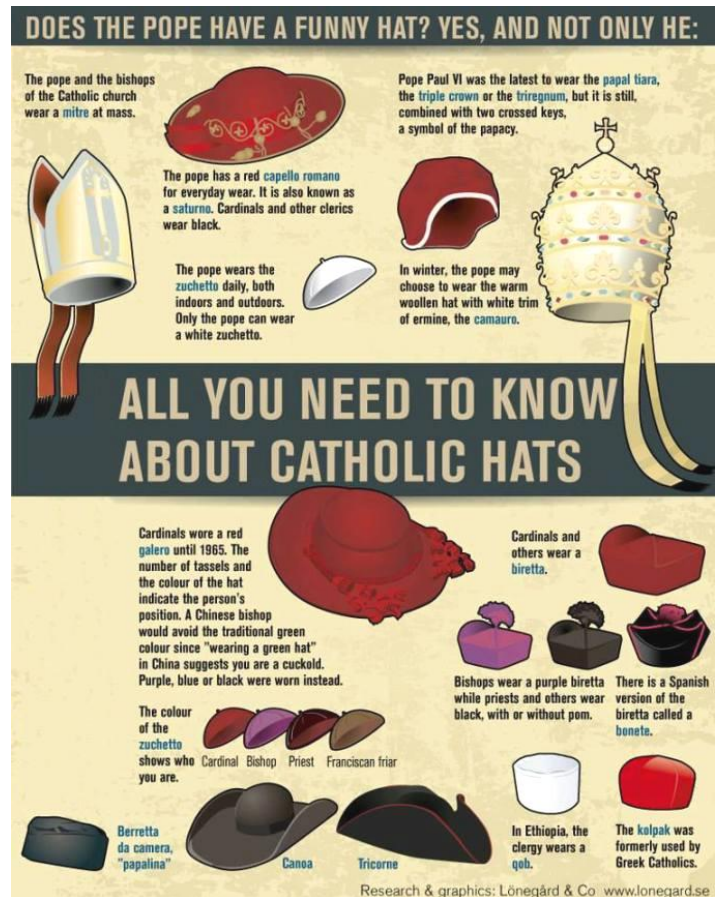


## St. Benedict Christmas Food & Clothing Drive
