2016 Year in Review

As is our custom at year's end, we take a look at the most significant developments in local Latin Mass circles over the past 12 months:

Arrival of the Institute of Christ the King at St. Joseph: The Archdiocese of Detroit establishes its first Extraordinary Form parish at a church long-known for Latin, *ad oriéntem* liturgy.

Debut of Regular Masses at Old St. Mary's: Good things come to those who wait...and work: After over 20 years of discussions and well over 50 meetings, Detroit's most centrally-located and well-outfitted church, Old St. Mary's, began monthly First Friday High Masses in the Extraordinary Form in 2016.

Debut of New Mass Sites: Special or regular Tridentine Masses continue to be held at more churches. In 2016 the Traditional Liturgy was held at the below sites for the first time ever, or in decades:

- 1. St. Michael, Pontiac
- 2. Miles Christi Family Center Chapel, South Lyon
- 3. St. Paul Albanian, Rochester Hills
- 4. St. Anne de Detroit (main church)
- 5. St. Joseph, Sarnia, Ontario

Prayer Pilgrimages & Extraordinary Faith: Our two local Tridentine-promoting ventures continue to produce: Mike Semaan's Prayer Pilgrimages bus tour operation has ventured forth with innovative tours of historic churches around the continent, traveling as far as Quebec and Mexico. *Extraordinary Faith* continues to offer its priest training program and completed the airing of its Season 1 on EWTN. Another 10+ episodes are planned for Season 2, debuting in 2017. The show was featured on *EWTN Live* in May, and weekly reruns of Season 1 episodes on all global EWTN English channels help expand the viewership.
