on Sunday, July 23 at 2:00 PM*

Thanks to the organizational efforts of Mike Semaan, a High Mass will be held at Holy Redeemer on Sunday, July 23 at 2:00 PM. The celebrant will be Fr. Ben Luedtke. All are invited to a reception in the parish hall after Mass.

One of Detroit's largest churches, Holy Redeemer is designed to resemble Rome's Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. The massive High Altar is surmounted by a half-baldacchino. The church retains all of its historic architectural features and is one of our region's most impressive sacred spaces, well worth a visit. Your presence at special Masses such as this indicates to the host parish and the organizers whether there is demand for future Masses at those locations, so we hope you can attend.

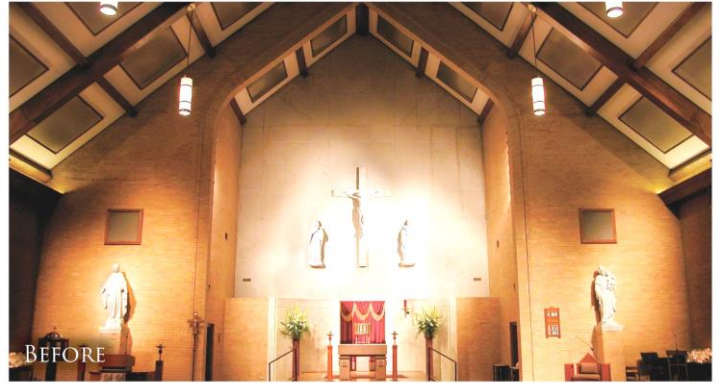
*Thursday Tridentine Masses Resume
