



Once again this year we are selling Wall Calendars for the Extraordinary Form from the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter. The schedule Feasts for the Traditional Latin Mass differs from that αf the

Ordinary Form, so the usual calendars parishes distribute are of little use to those who attend the Tridentine Mass.

Sign up sheets are available at the missal tables at the Oakland County Latin Mass Association/Academy of the Sacred Heart Chapel, St. Benedict Tridentine Community at St. Alphonsus and Holy Name of Mary Churches, and at Old St. Mary's Church. The

cost is \$13.00 U.S. or \$17.00 Canadian, and prepayment is requested.

be gained by way of prayers or acts performed on those days. The advertisement makes no mention of whether the Feast Days are listed according to the Ordinary or Extraordinary Forms, so one must assume it is a Novus Ordo calendar. Nevertheless there are only a handful of Plenary Indulgenced Feast Days whose dates differ in the EF, so it is still an interesting resource.
