2018 Year in Review

Oakland County Latin Mass Association

As is our custom at year's end, we take a look at the most significant developments in the local Latin Mass scene over the past 12 months:

Increasing Attendance at Most Local Tridentine Mass Sites:

Despite more churches adding the Traditional Mass either on a regular basis (e.g.: St. Mary in St. Clair, Michigan) or on special occasions (e.g.: St. Francis d'Assisi, Detroit) and other churches increasing the frequency of existing TLM offerings (e.g.: Immaculate Conception, Lapeer, Michigan), attendance at most if not all Latin Mass sites in metro Detroit and Windsor continues to increase. Some are even astounding (e.g.: Old St. Mary's First Friday Mass often attracting over 200 faithful). New Latin Mass sites aren't stealing faithful from other sites, they're growing the pool of interested Catholics.

Growth in Priest Training: 2018 was the busiest year yet for training priests in celebrating the Extraordinary Form, both locally and nationally. In Detroit, the Franciscans of the Holy Spirit and the Companions of the Cross are starting to celebrate the TLM. At the Sacred Liturgy Conference in Oregon, over 20 priests, deacons, and seminarians attended the celebrant training sessions, far more than were expected. Requests for individual training sessions are becoming more frequent. Despite all of the problems in the global Church, at the grass roots level, interest in Tradition is stronger than ever.

Architectural Restorations: The pace of churches restoring or installing for the first time traditional architectural elements continues to increase, even in unexpected places (e.g.: Solanus Center, Detroit). Communion Rails in particular are making a noteworthy comeback, locally (e.g.: Our Lady of Czestochowa in Sterling Heights, Michigan) and nationally. Conversely, controversial wreckovations of historic churches seem to be on the decline. Virtually no young clergy this writer knows desire whitewashed, overly simplified worship spaces.
