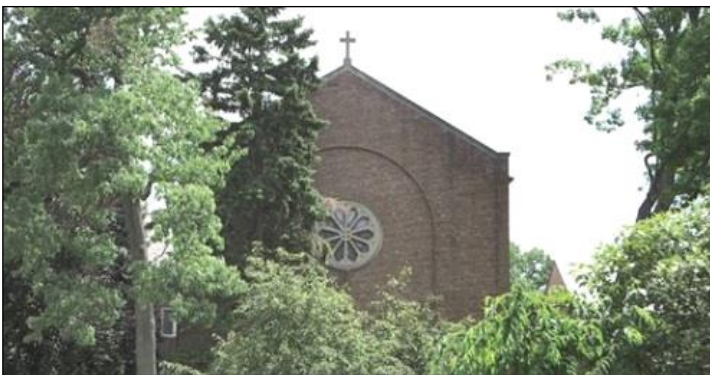
March 8, 2020 – Second Sunday of Lent
