38th Metro Detroit Tridentine Mass Site Debuts: Our Lady of Good Counsel, Plymouth

Many of our readers know Fr. Michael Suhy, formerly known by his religious name of Fr. Clement Suhy. Like Fr. John McKenzie, Fr. Suhy had earlier been a monk of Norcia, the Benedictine community in Italy that celebrates exclusively the Traditional Mass. Upon returning to metro Detroit because of a family necessity, Fr. Suhy became known as a roving celebrant of the Extraordinary Form. He was the initiator of the Tridentine Masses at Immaculate Conception, Lapeer, which continue to this day. He celebrated numerous special Masses at Holy Redeemer, Detroit. At one point he was assigned as Associate Pastor of Our Lady of Good Counsel in Plymouth, and a few years later, upon the reassignment of former Pastor Fr. John Riccardo, was named successor Pastor. Lee Acervo, and Fr. David Bechill]. Under Fr. Riccardo, the parish also began to offer some of its Ordinary Form Masses *ad orientem*.



At the request of several parishioners, Fr. Suhy has decided to initiate a Tridentine Mass at Good Counsel on Third Tuesdays of the month at 6:00 PM, with the debut being a High Mass on October 20. It is excellent news that this, one of the Archdiocese's largest parishes, both in terms of number of parishioners and physical plant size, is making a commitment to the immemorial Mass.
