Old St. Mary's Debuts Monthly Sunday Tridentine Masses



Downtown Detroit's grand Old St. Mary's Church will debut once-a-month Sunday 10:00 AM High Masses in the Extraordinary Form on November 15. In December the Mass will be on December 13. This is in addition to the 7:00 PM First Friday Masses, which will continue. Fr. Cy Whitaker, SJ will celebrate the November 15 Mass.

Special guest Music Director for the November 15 Mass will be Dr. Steven Ball. Former organist at Detroit's Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, former Carillonneur at the University of Michigan Ann Arbor, and former custodian of the world's largest pipe organ, at Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, New Jersey, Steven was a regular sight subbing at Tridentine Masses around metro Detroit when he used to live in the region. Steven will be Artist-in-Residence at Old St. Mary's and will assist Wassim Sarweh, who remains Music Director of the parish's Extraordinary Form Masses.

Special Extension of Plenary Indulgences for November

This year, per special Vatican ruling, for the entire month of November, a Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, may be gained each day by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead, even if only mentally. The Plenary Indulgence traditionally offered only on November 2 for those who visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed can also be gained on any day in November. The usual conditions apply for Plenary Indulgences: Confession within 20 days, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the Holy Father's intentions (traditionally one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be) once per Plenary Indulgence sought, and freedom from attachment to sin. A maximum of one Plenary Indulgence may be gained per day.
