The Litany of St. Joseph

Perhaps the easiest of the special Plenary Indulgences to be gained during the Year of St. Joseph is praying the Litany of St. Joseph “in favour of the Church persecuted *ad intra* and *ad extra* [internally and externally] and for the relief of all Christians who suffer any form of persecution.” This indulgence may be gained daily through December 8, 2021, under the usual conditions of reception of Holy Communion once per Plenary Indulgence sought, Confession within 20 days, prayer for the Holy Father’s intentions, and freedom from attachment to sin. Note that the English version from the *Manual of Indulgences* differs slightly from the traditional Latin version. There does not seem to exist a Latin version matching the current English translation.
