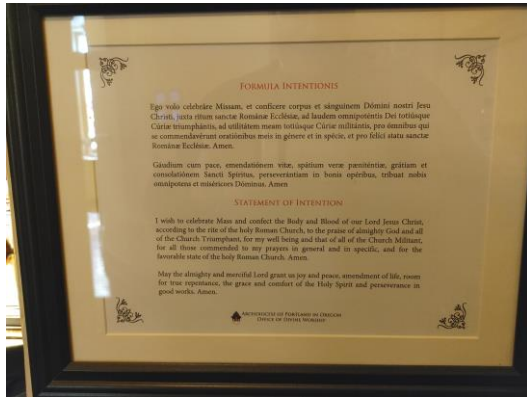

The Archdiocese of Portland, Oregon is known for its high standards of liturgy. Home to two renowned choral groups, *Cantóres in Ecclesiá* and *Schola Cantus Angelórum*, the diocese and its Archbishop Alexander Sample promote quality liturgy in both the Ordinary and Extraordinary Forms. For the OF, they are known for authoring the *Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook*,
