The Three Masses of All Souls Day





Continuing a tradition unbroken in metro Detroit and Windsor since 2007, the Three Masses of All Souls Day will be held once again, this year at the Oakland County Latin Mass Association / Archdiocesan Shrine Chapel of St. John Paul II at Orchard Lake, on Tuesday, November 2. Two simultaneous Low Masses will be offered at the Side Altars of the chapel at 6:00 PM, followed by a Solemn High Mass with Deacon and Subdeacon at the High Altar at 7:00 PM. The ceremony of Absolution at the Catafalque will be held at the end of the Solemn High Mass. Holy Communion will be distributed at all three Masses. Canon Law allows Catholics to receive Holy Communion up to two times in one day, provided that the second time is at a Mass and not a simple Communion Service, which is not an issue at this event.

Holy Mother Church grants a Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, to those who visit a church or oratory on All Souls Day (the Orchard Lake Shrine Chapel qualifies) and there prays an Our Father and a Creed, under the usual conditions of Confession within 20 days, reception of Holy Communion, prayer for the Holy Father's intentions, and freedom from attachment to sin.

The Latin Liturgy Association, which promotes the celebration of both the Ordinary and Extraordinary Forms of Holy Mass in the Latin language, and which publishes a quarterly newsletter and organizes conferences, has announced two generous programs:

The Word documents are easily customizable, with music and announcements to suit the needs of any TLM chapel or church. Handouts for Baptisms and the Churching of Women are also available.

These handouts began to be created in 2004, when it became evident that none of the other Propers sources on the Internet were sufficiently high quality. All of the others were and still are plagued by typos, incorrect scriptural citations, mismatches between the Latin and English, and so forth. The only solution was to create a fresh, thoroughly proofread set of Propers from scratch. Now that this time-consuming work has been completed, no one should have to reinvent the wheel.
