2021 Year in Review

As is our annual custom, we present a list of some of the most significant local Latin Mass developments from the past year:

Growth Despite Challenges: Though Covid and the July 16 Motu Proprio *Traditiónis Custódes* presented challenges, 2021 had more good news than bad on the Traditional Latin Mass front. Attendance continues to increase at most TLM sites, both locally and globally. At least three Pontifical Masses were held in our region (Bishop Hanchon, Bishop Boyea, and Bishop Schneider). The Archdioceses of San Francisco and Portland (Oregon) set good examples of how the TLM scene can be encouraged to grow if the bishop desires and supports that. San Francisco even explicitly seeks to replicate "the Detroit TLM Miracle" [their words].

More Churches Offer Tridentine Masses: The Blue Army's Fatima Shrine in Riverview opened their doors for the first time this year for celebrations of the Traditional Mass. The TLM returned to St. Josaphat, since temporarily relocated to Sweetest Heart of Mary. After the success of their Monday-Wednesday-Friday Low Masses, Holy Family Detroit debuted monthly First Sunday High Masses. Holy Family Saginaw's TLM went from special occasions to every Sunday. St. Thomas the Apostle Ann Arbor continued to expand their TLM offerings, with numerous special occasion Masses complementing their weekly Sunday Mass.
