# Catholic Camelot: The Era of the 1950 Detroit Catholic Directory

A reader loaned us a copy of the 1950 Catholic Directory and Guide, published by the Archdiocese of Detroit. This writer has later copies of the same directory, one from 1983 and one from 1994, however the 1950 edition is quite eye-opening as to the vivacity of Catholic life in our region in that period. Every parish's Mass schedule is listed, and boy, were they ever busy. Consider the numerous Masses on offer at St. Aloysius in downtown Detroit; their upper and lower churches and Side Altars must have been bustling with activity. And this was not unusual; most parishes offered an astounding number of Masses.
