This historic church, one of whose early pastors composed the hymn Sweet Sacrament Divine, was recently restored and named the Archdiocesan Shrine of the Blessed Sacrament.



The Westminster Archdiocese did a podcast interview, "The Eucharist as the Sacrament of Unity", in 2021 with some of the priest coordinators of the event. Churches known for the Latin Mass, including Corpus Christi Maiden Lane, St. James Spanish Place, and the Jesuit Farm Street Church, were represented in the lively discussion.
