

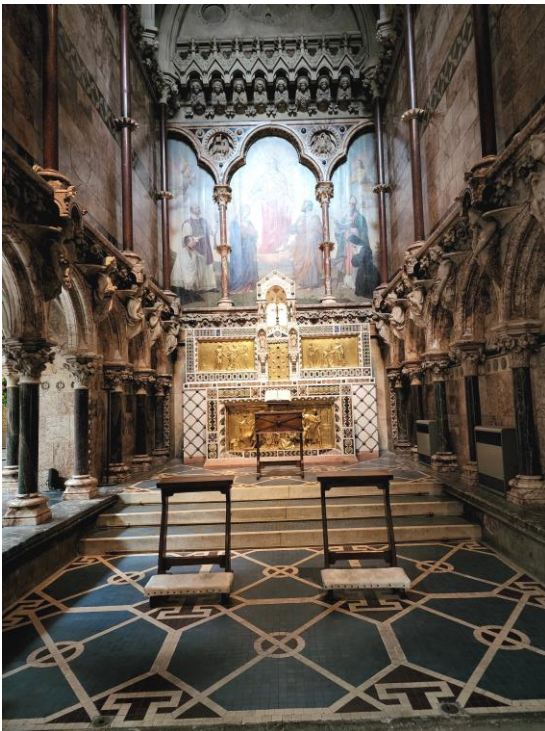

## *The Beautiful Side Chapels of London, England*

The July 19, 2020 edition of this column described the impressive gallery of side chapels (with altars) at London, England's massive Rosary Shrine Church. There are 15 chapels, one for each mystery of the Rosary. Resident parish priest Fr. Lawrence Lew, OP offers the traditional Dominican Rite on those altars.

On a trip to London last week, this writer noted that elaborate side chapels are a common feature in London's historic churches, many of which host the Extraordinary Form and/or the Ordinary Form in Latin. Consider the following examples from, in order, the London Oratory, Farm Street Jesuit Church, Westminster Cathedral, St. Mary Cadogan Street, and St. James Spanish Place. The Traditional Mass is offered on these altars at the Oratory, Westminster Cathedral, and St. James Spanish Place.
