2022 Year in Review

As is our annual custom, we present a list of some of the most significant local Latin Mass developments from the past year:

Detroit & Windsor Continue to Set the Pace for North America: In spite of the challenges presented by the 2021 Motu Proprio *Traditiónis Custódes*, there continues to be good news on the local Traditional Latin Mass front. Attendance continues to increase at most TLM sites. Metro Detroit continued to attract attention for its TLM successes, first at a talk given about regional team building at the Sacra Liturgía conference in San Francisco in June, and then in a New York Times article in November. Priest training in celebrating the TLM continues, both locally and throughout North America.

Growth and Upgrades: St. Thomas the Apostle, Ann Arbor continued to expand their TLM offerings, with numerous special occasion Masses complementing their weekly Sunday Mass. Attendance at St. Thomas' Sunday Mass has increased to 300-450 weekly. Ss. Peter & Paul Westside has upgraded many of their Sunday and weekday Masses from Low Masses to High Masses. Holy Family, Detroit increased the frequency of their Sunday TLMs from monthly to weekly, and attendance at those Masses has increased from only 15-20 pre-TLM to over 100 now. The Academy of the Sacred Heart has welcomed the Oakland County Latin Mass Association back for weekday Masses. St. Vincent de Paul, Pontiac debuted Saturday Tridentine Masses during Lent.
