Hillsdale College Chapel Hosts Another Tridentine Mass



For at least the second time since its construction, the new Christ Chapel at Hillsdale College hosted a Tridentine High Mass, on Friday, December 2, 2022. The Mass was organized by the Jackson, Michigan Tridentine Community at St. Mary Star of the Sea Church and celebrated by St. Mary's pastor Fr. Tim Nelson. The chapel has gained much press because it was designed by celebrated Catholic architect Duncan Stroik.

Jackson TLM organizer Jeff Mausolf reports that "99%" of the approximately 150 in attendance were students, an encouraging sign of hope for the future.

Catechesis Through Sacred Art from St. Agnes Parish, St. Paul, Minnesota

One of the best-known traditional parish/school combinations in North America is St. Agnes in St. Paul, Minnesota. Featured in Episode 3 of *Extraordinary Faith*, St. Agnes offers both the Traditional Latin Mass and the *Novus Ordo ad orientem* in Latin, along with a classical school offering grades PreK-12. The school publishes a glossy magazine geared towards alumni, *The Aggie Archives*. The current issue includes a column called *Liturgical Living*, with the first article entitled "Catechesis Through Sacred Art: Vestments".

Besides providing an explanation of vestments and liturgical colors, the article, written by pastor Fr. Mark Moriarty, contains this fascinating tidbit:



"...the Roman soldier, Martin, encountered an under-dressed and cold beggar. Martin took his cape and cut it in half, giving one piece of it to the poor man. Later Martin discovered in a vision that it was really Jesus in disguise. After Martin became a Bishop of Tours, a small church was built to hold the surviving half of Martin's cape. The little building was named after the 'little cape', or in French, 'chapelle'. This is where we get our word for small churches, chapels."
