Non-Parish Churches & Chapels in Metro Detroit Part 3 of 4

The third installment in our series on local non-parish churches and chapels that could host the Traditional Latin Mass covers sites in Windsor.

9. **Holy Name of Mary Church:** Canonically suppressed as a parish on June 28, 2009, Holy Name of Mary Church is maintained by Assumption Parish and is primarily used for Masses of the St. Benedict Tridentine Community on First Sundays of the month at 2:00 PM and every Tuesday at 7:00 PM.



10. **St. Rose Church:** Extensively covered in our February 19, 2023 column, St. Rose Church on the east side of Windsor closed in 2009 and was later sold to an investor whose main interest was in leasing out the former rectory as apartments. The church itself sits unused.



11. **Academie Ste. Cecile Chapel:** Built in 1957 as Holy Redeemer College, a Redemptorist seminary, this expansive campus is now the privately owned Academie Ste. Cecile International School. Its chapel includes a Casavant organ.



12. **Madonna di Canneto Chapel at the Ciociaro Club:** The Ciociaro Club is a massive banquet facility known for hosting the annual Bishop's Dinner for St. Peter's Seminary that typically attracts 1,000 attendees. The club has on its campus a freestanding chapel that is rarely used, a replica of the Basilica-Shrine of Mary of Canneto in Italy.
