Non-Parish Churches & Chapels in Metro Detroit Addendum #1

An additional chapel has come to our attention:

18. **St. Edward Chapel at Ascension St. John Hospital:** Completed in 1964, the large St. John Hospital Chapel in Detroit near Grosse Pointe has traditional Confessionals, Side Altars, and a Communion Rail. (Novus Ordo) Mass is offered there every Wednesday at 11:30 AM (no longer daily; their web site is incorrect).



There is also a chapel at Beaumont Hospital Grosse Pointe, the Bon Secours Chapel, however it has been modernized to the point where it would not be a desirable location for the Traditional Mass. Interestingly, a (Novus Ordo) wedding was held in that chapel a few years ago.

While in this post-Covid era it may seem odd to consider a hospital chapel as a viable site, it's worth noting that the London, Ontario Tridentine Mass Community was for many years based at the beautiful St. Joseph Hospital Chapel, hidden away deep in the hallways of an upper floor.



It even had a choir loft. The risk with such chapels, of course, is that another pandemic could make them inaccessible to the public.



Also worth acknowledging is the IHM Motherhouse Chapel in Monroe, which is open to the public for Masses. While the chapel itself has been modernized in some ways, it would still be a fine home for the Traditional Mass. with a High Altar. Side Altars. Communion Rail, and Casavant pipe organ. Realistically, however, the IHM sisters would be unlikely to permit such a Mass in their facility.

Finally, a canon lawyer has brought to our attention that in a parish that has more than one church, only one church is designated as the "parish church." Secondary, non-parish churches in our region include St. Michael Church at St. Damien of Molokai Parish in Pontiac; St. James Church at Our Mother of Perpetual Help Parish in Ferndale; and [the temporarily shuttered] St. Josaphat Church at Mother of Divine Mercy Parish in Detroit.
