New Solemn Red Vestment Set

St. Benedict Tridentine Community's Solemn High Mass at St. Alphonsus Church, Windsor on Pentecost Sunday served as the debut of a new red solemn vestment set, the first such set in metro Detroit which will be made available on loan for special occasions to other Traditional Mass sites. Like all of the vestment sets commissioned by Fr. Peter Hrytsyk, this set was made by the Sister Servants of Mary Immaculate of Toronto, using fabric from Lalame of New York City.
