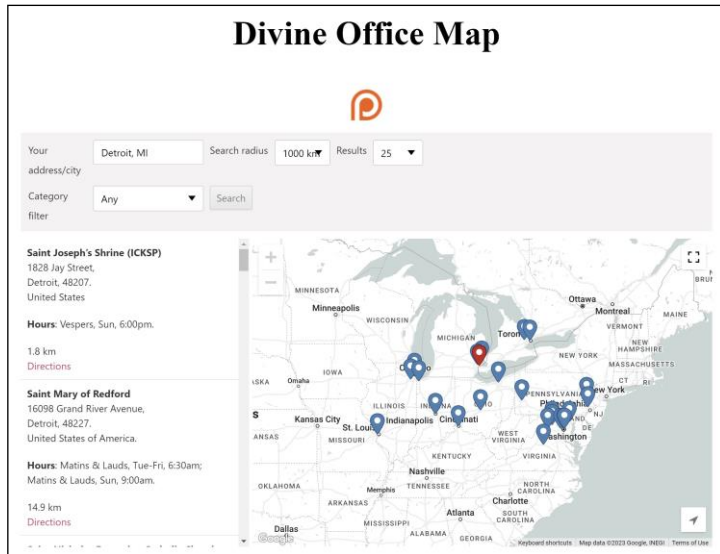

There is no shortage of web sites that, with varying degrees of completeness and accuracy, strive to list the times and locations of Tridentine Masses offered in North America. Until now, however, there has been no comparable effort to catalog locations where the Divine Office – both Ordinary and Extraordinary Forms – is offered publicly.



That is changing with the debut of the Divine Office Locator web site. Still in its infancy and not yet a thorough cataloging of all sites, they already list Detroit's St. Mary of Redford and St. Joseph Shrine. ## *Neumz App to Include Tridentine Mass Chants*

Our April 18, 2021 column carried news of a project called “Neumz”, described as “The entire Gregorian chant repertory, recorded by the community of Benedictine nuns of the Abbey of Notre-Dame de Fidélité of Jouques, in French Provence.” At that time, over 7,000 hours of chant had been recorded and were playable in apps for Android and iOS. There are different subscription tiers, the lowest being free, that allow an increasing amount of selectability of the chant heard. The app provides the musical notation, Latin lyrics, and vernacular translation for each chant. Neumz was initially designed only to include chants for the Ordinary Form, but last December on Twitter/X, they announced that Extraordinary Form chants would soon be available, with recordings made at France’s Le Barroux Abbey.

The project is well funded: “Neumz is part of a three-year project named REPERTORIUM that has been awarded a 3 million euro Horizon Research and Innovation grant by the European Commission.”
