

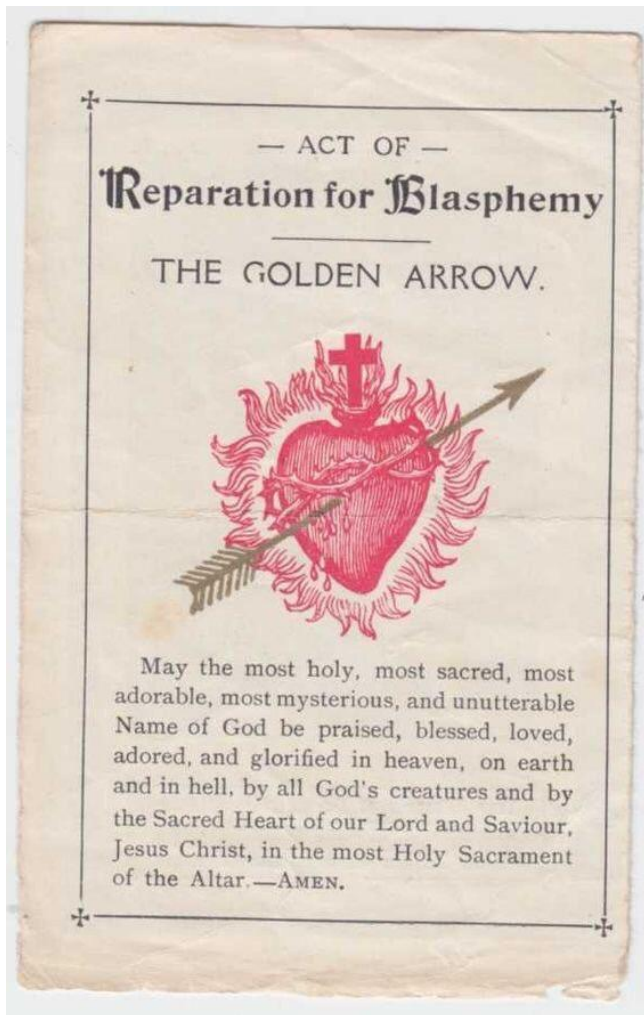

The Golden Arrow Prayer

As the below holy card indicates, a beautiful and well-known Act of Reparation for Blasphemy is the so-called Golden Arrow Prayer. It is meant as an act of reparation for the profanation of Sundays and of Holy Days of Obligation, as well. A more commonly found version of the text is as follows:

May the most holy, most sacred, most adorable, most incomprehensible and unutterable Name of God be always praised, blessed, loved, adored and glorified in Heaven, on earth, and under the earth, by all the creatures of God, and by the Sacred Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Amen.
