Next up is a shot of the Papal Altar at St. Peter's. The baldacchino by Bernini which surmounts it is currently undergoing its first major restoration in more than 250 years.



Bavaria is known for its over-the-top Baroque and Rococo churches. First, a shot of Ottobeuren Abbey, a Benedictine monastery with a breathtaking interior. The Fraternity of St. Peter has conducted ordinations in the Extraordinary Form and held Vespers in this church.



The similarly ornate Wieskirche is a popular tourist stop. This church has been the site of several prominent organ recordings. A bonus: There is a freestanding tiny chapel outside the main church, a miniature sidekick, beautiful in its own right.
