

Tridentine Masses to Continue at Old St. Mary's

Old St. Mary's, Detroit (12:15 PM Tuesday – Saturday) – Confessions before most Masses. Kneeling for Holy Communion at the rail. https://www.oldstmarysdetroit.com/

St. Aloysius, Detroit (12:15 PM Monday – Thursday) – Confessions before Mass. Holy Hour and Benediction before Mass on Thursdays. https://www.staloysiusdetroit.com/

St. Mary, Royal Oak (7:30 AM Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday; 12:10 PM Wednesday). https://www.stmaryroyaloak.com/

St. Edward Chapel at Ascension St. John Hospital, Detroit (Wednesday at 11:30 AM) – Beautiful and large chapel [pictured below]; ask hospital staff how to get there, as it is hard to find. Chaplain always uses Eucharistic Prayer I.
