The occasion? London Oratory Schola Music Director Charles Cole was visiting the area to prepare for his choir's concert at Old St. Mary's in Detroit on Friday, July 18 at 7:30 PM. Detroit Latin Mass Mob

The Detroit Mass Mob movement, led until his recent passing by Thom Mann, was a tremendous success in bringing renewed attention to often forgotten and underutilized historic Detroit Catholic churches. Hundreds if not thousands of people would attend these occasional Masses, for example see the adjacent photo of the 2,200 seat St. Albertus Church filled to capacity at a Mass Mob. In an effort to replicate this success, an enterprising young lady has organized a Latin Mass Mob that will be visiting (mostly) parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit that will be losing their TLMs after June. Exceptions are St. Joseph Shrine, which is immune to the latest cutbacks, and the St. John Resort Chapel, which being a non-parish church may be allowed to continue its Third Tuesday Masses. Unfortunately her list omits the Oakland County Latin Mass Association's 9:00 AM Sunday Mass at the

Orchard Lake Shrine Chapel, though that site, too, will likely survive the cancellations.
