List of Tridentine Masses in Metro Detroit & Windsor

Below we present an updated listing of the Traditional Latin Masses in metro Detroit and Windsor, reflecting the significant reduction in Mass sites in the Archdiocese of Detroit as mandated by Archbishop Weisenburger effective July 1, 2025. One of the most notable changes is the elimination of weekday Masses in the Archdiocese of Detroit, apart from those at St. Joseph Shrine. Even priests' private Masses are now tightly regulated.

While metro Detroit & Windsor can no longer claim to have the most TLM sites in North America, in conjunction with neighboring dioceses we do still have more than many other major cities. This list includes both "regular" (at least once per month on predictable days) and "special" (infrequent and/or varying dates) Mass sites.

Discontinued Sites and Their Priests

Please pray for the priests and attendees of these sites in the Archdiocese of Detroit, which have lost their regularly scheduled TLMs. Laypeople can generally switch to a new location with only drive time and time of day presenting possible inconveniences, whereas priests are obligated to their assignments and may therefore effectively lose all of their access to the Traditional Mass.

There are also 12 special occasion Mass sites which can no longer host Tridentine Masses, such as St. Aloysius, Detroit and the Basilica of Ste. Anne, Detroit. Overall these changes represent a decrease from a grand total of 41 sites in the region previously down to 12 sites at present, a reduction of 71%.
