

## The Sanctífica App

As our series of articles on the Divine Office has been pointing out, an increasing number of phone apps has been appearing which cater to the needs of Traditional Catholics.

One relatively new app to hit the scene is *Sanctifica*. Available for both Android and iOS, *Sanctifica* includes information on the Saint of the day, the Traditional Mass Propers of the day, the hours of the Divine Office for the day, Novenas that are appropriate to the time of year, plus a fairly large collection of devotional prayers.



It also includes a map showing Tridentine Mass locations. This list is not all that useful, unfortunately, as it only lists locations, not Mass times, and in the case of metro Detroit, there are errors, omissions, and duplicate listings. Also, while not the fault of the publisher, sites that have been abolished by Archbishop Weisenburger as of July 1, 2025 are still listed. Nonetheless some information is better than none, and hopefully in time users will submit feedback that makes the listings more accurate and useful.
