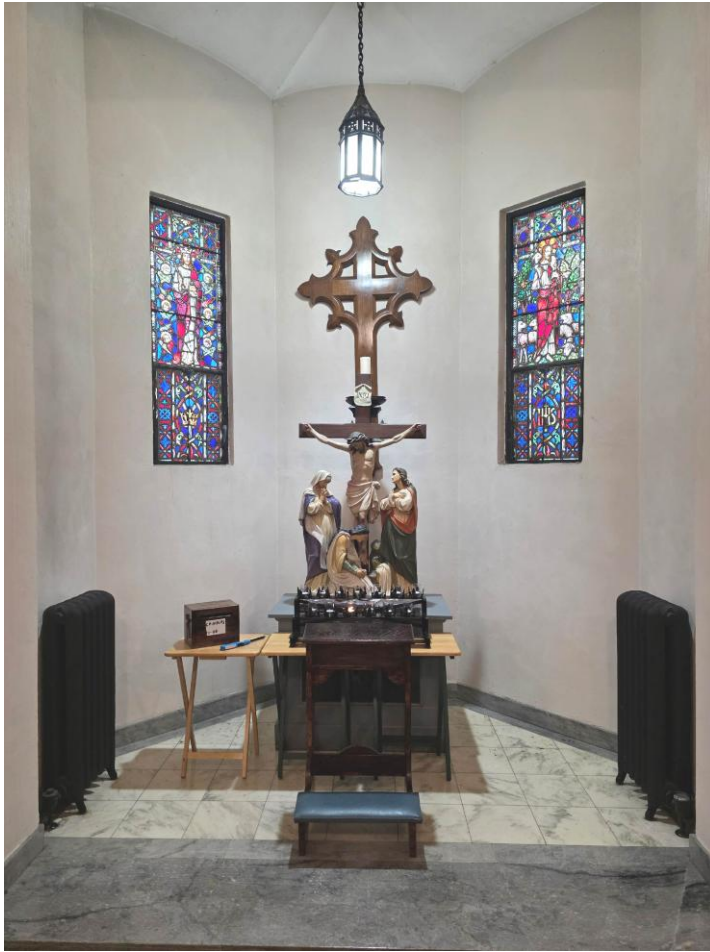

Crucifixion Shrine Restored and Bell System Repaired

Holy Name of Mary Church, Windsor caretaker Tim McKinley discovered the components of a shrine to the Crucifixion in pieces in a storage area. He carefully cleaned and reassembled the parts, including a matching votive candle stand, and set it up in the right transept of the church. Candles were ordered and are available to be lit. An offering box has been set up to cover the cost of the candles.



In addition, Matthew Caza and Tim recently repaired the electric tower bell ringing mechanism, so that the smallest and largest bells can be rung by flipping a switch, while the middle bell for the time being remains ringable manually by rope. Currently the middle bell is rung at the consecrations of the St. Benedict Tridentine Community's Masses at Holy Name of Mary, but the restored functionality allows the other bells to be rung conveniently at other times. Thanks to Tim, Matthew, and the other volunteers from St. Benedict for continually thinking of ways to improve this important Latin Mass site in our region.

Historic Photo of Toledo Cathedral

The Facebook page Churches of Ohio on March 4, 2026 posted the below historic photo of Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral in Toledo, Ohio. While the cathedral overall

remains in quite good shape today, they strangely removed the High Altar from underneath the baldacchino that is depicted in the picture; it has been replaced by a king-size Baptismal Font, complete with a lid that can be lowered onto it from inside the top of the baldacchino. One could argue that this sends an odd message about Baptism being a more central Sacrament than the Eucharist.
