The next Sacred Liturgy Conference will be held August 3-7, 2027 in Bend, Oregon.

An amazing 64 students from Ann Arbor and surroundings participated in the second annual Chant Camp at St. Thomas the Apostle Church in Ann Arbor during the week of July 6, culminating in a Tridentine Mass on Friday, July 10 at noon attended by approximately 200 faithful. Canticle director Mary Ann Carr Wilson led the instruction. St. Thomas' recently ordained Parochial Vicar Fr. Ryan Ferrigan also took part in the training. Before returning home to San Diego on Sunday, July 12, Mary Ann sang with the Oakland County Latin Mass Association choir at the Orchard Lake Shrine Chapel. Plans are being made for another Canticle Chant Camp in our region in the summer of
